Contest Dates: July 2nd & 3rd Weekend (Saturday & Sunday of each year)

Definitions of Evaluation Criteria

Technical - Grades in the Technical area gauge the quality of the performer, expressing the level of foundational technical ability and physical skills.

Technique: Evaluation of physical dexterity on the fingerboard and with the bow. Adjudicators are looking for physical strength, endurance, proper hand positions, posture, and accuracy.

Tone: Evaluation of tone quality and pitch accuracy (playing in tune). Adjudicators are looking for a good full sound played with confidence and maturity, and proper pitch intonation within the instrument as well as pitch agreement with the accompanist.

Performance - Grades in the Performance area represent elements of that specific performance.

Accuracy: Specific mistakes are noted as negative error points and keyed to bars in the music. Error points are valued according to severity. The error point total is subtracted from the final grade. Wrongs notes, inaccuracies of rhythm and incorrect intonation may earn subtractive points.

Dynamics: Evaluation of musicality and accurate observation of written dynamics. Sensitivity and emotion are graded along with the performer's accurate reading of written dynamics.

Stage Presence: Evaluation of the performer's poise, showmanship, and relationship to the audience. The performer's attitude is evaluated along with the student's ability to engage the audience in the musical experience.

Quality: Evaluation of the overall quality of the listening experience.

Repertoire - Grades in the Repertoire area rate considerations of the musical selection.

Demand: A rating of the difficulty of the written music.

Tempo: A rating of the speed and rhythmic demands of the music and the performer's adherence to written tempos.

Special Consideration: Bonus points are awarded for performing above and beyond normal or reasonable expectations. This may include but is not limited to overcoming distractions or difficulties of the performing situation, or if a performer selects and performs well a piece of music normally reserved for a more experienced player.

Satori Strings Contest

Contest Rules

1. All solo music must be memorized in order for the contestant to be eligible for a prize or placement.
2. Contestants entered in more than one secondary category (Solo, Baroque, American) must use a different repertoire for each category.
3. Solo contestants may only be entered in one primary category (Prodigy, Open, Qualified, Jr. Qualified, Entry Qualified).
4. Ensembles may only be entered in one primary category (Open, Qualified).
5. Ensemble contestants must supply their own accompanists.
6. Ensemble contestants may not compete more than once in the same category.
7. Ensemble age categories are based on the age of the eldest member.
8. First place winners may not re-enter the same or a lower category the year following their first place win.
9. Contact between the judges and contestants, teachers and parents is prohibited before, during and after the contest.
10. Contestants must be present at the awards ceremony or the front desk after the winners' announcement to receive their awards. Awards left unclaimed at the awards ceremony will be offered to the next runner up in that category.
11. Contestants' contest schedule is selected at random.
12. If more than 6 contestants enroll in a particular category age group, that section may be split into two categories.

Contest Entry Details

- ◆ All contestants should show a proof of age document.
- ◆ Categorical age placement is determined by the contestant's age on July 1.
- ◆ All contestants must provide a copy of the music to be performed for the judges.
- ◆ All contestants should submit entry forms by Deadline set for the year. Late entries may be accommodated for an additional \$10 processing fee for each contestant.

Contest Categories

Prodigy Solo Categories – for superior students performing repertoire of a serious competitive nature. The best four performers in each category will win a beautiful commemorative medal. The first place winner of each category may advance to the grand prize contest. Performance consists of two contrasting pieces or movements, one accompanied and one unaccompanied, not to exceed 10 minutes total.
